What We're (You+Us) Doing Around the World

While most of Doug's work life centers around East Asia, he also plays a part in CCC's Global Technology Leadership Team. Twice a year, these visionary men and women meet to help our ministry around the world use technology for the glory of God. At his last meeting, he met and worked with a young African man named Miheret.

Miheret was born in a small town called Arsi Negelle. When he was 10 years old, he was sent to another village to go to school. While there, he became very ill with malaria.

In the hospital the doctors told his mother to take him home to die, saying there was no hope for his recovery. His mother kept him in the hospital, praying for him continually. She said "no he will not die. God gave all my children to me and they will all live to give glory to God." God

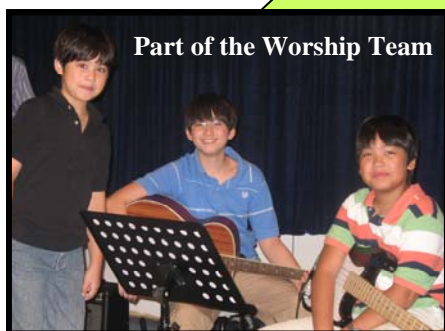
answered her prayers and Miheret recovered. Miheret was then sent to a large town where he went to secondary school and university. In grade 12, while on a mission trip, God spoke to him in a vision that He would use Miheret to reach many people for Him using technology. Because of God's word to him, Miheret chose to study computer science at the university. He became involved with Campus Crusade as a student and was able to attend several training conferences.

After he graduated from the university, he wanted to join CCC staff but knew that he would end up on campus and he felt that God was still calling him into a ministry using technology. So he worked professionally in a telecommunications company for 1 year and had a ministry with young professionals. In

his spare time, he began working as an online missionary with CCC's Global Media Outreach (GMO) and was excited to have a worldwide impact using technology. Eventually, he left his work in telecommunications and joined the staff of CCC in Ethiopia in 2008. His vision is to build a communications center in Ethiopia using technology to reach the world for Christ.

2009 was an amazing year. GMO presented the gospel to over 66 million people around the world through its more than 100 web sites. In December, we saw the 10 millionth person for the year indicate a decision for Jesus. Our Online Missionaries responded to more than 1.8 million requests for follow-up.
